Welcome to the Neighborhood Health Clinic!

OUR CLINIC HOURS ARE:

**Monday and Thursday Clinic
3:00pm – 7:00pm**

New patients coming to the Clinic for the first time must arrive and sign in at the front desk no later than 5:00pm. All other patients must sign in at the front desk by 6:00pm.

**Saturday Morning Clinic
8:30AM – 11:00am
(EVERY OTHER SATURDAY - CALL FOR MORE INFORMATION)**

New patients coming to the clinic for the first time must arrive and sign in no later than 10:00am. All other patients must arrive by 10:30am.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY OUR PATIENT GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY

1. The Neighborhood Health Clinic is a medical clinic that treats patients who have an acute, episodic or chronic illness. The Clinic does not provide employment physicals or "well" patient examinations.
2. AGE: Patients must be **19 to 64 years of age** and a Collier County resident for the past 30 days.
3. Patients must be **employed and provide 30 days documentation of work for a minimum of 20 hours a week**. A patient's total family income must be at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Income Level. This number is determined by the Federal Government. Patients must provide one month's most recent pay stubs for all family members who are working. Patients must bring in current pay-stubs **each time** they visit the Clinic. Income tax form is required of those who file taxes.
4. Patients who have **access to health insurance** through their employer, spouse's health insurance, Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security, Disability Insurance, Worker's Compensation or Unemployment Benefits will not qualify.
5. New patients will be asked to contribute \$30.00 for their initial visit. Returning patients contribute a minimum of \$20.00 each time they visit the Clinic.
6. The Clinic does not treat patients with AIDS, tuberculosis, pregnancy or pregnancy related conditions. These services are provided by Collier County Health Department.

The Neighborhood Health Clinic is supported only by private donations and is staffed by medical volunteers. **FINAL DETERMINATION FOR A PATIENT TO QUALIFY AT OUR FACILITY IS BY THE GOVERNANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND ELIGIBILITY DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AVAILABILITY OF SERVICES..**
